


Hi Crew and Yuletide Greetings this chilly December!!!

Since cold or snow won't keep many of you grounded, make sure you have a safe and uneventful flight with this helpful information.

Here is a brief list of the seven tips he offers for preparing your airplane for the colder weather:

Wash, wax, and detail the exterior; Change the oil; Lubricate the airframe; Charge, maintain, or replace batteries; Inspect the heating system; Prepare for preheating; Be prepared!

If you see some low flyers in parts southeast Missouri and southern Illinois beginning in late November 2018 through March 2019. The mapping will be used to make 3D surface maps of mining districts and seismic implications within the New Madrid Seismic Zone.
